Registration, including online, begins at 8:00 am on Monday, May 5, 2014.

- in person, mailed to the [City of Casa Grande Parks and Recreation Department, 404 E. Florence Blvd., Casa Grande, AZ 85122](#).

Participants must be registered with the Parks and Recreation office to use the online service. Online registrations are processed in real time. A confirmation can be printed at the end of the online process. This is highly recommended as this will serve as notice for you to attend on the specific start date. You will not be able to attend if your name is not on the class/activity roster. If you did not receive a confirmation prior to your class/activity, call (520) 421-8677 or e-mail us at parksrec@casagrandeaz.gov.

NOTE: WHEN A CLASS SESSION OCCURS OVER A HOLIDAY, THERE WILL BE NO CLASS ON THAT PARTICULAR DAY. (MEMORIAL DAY MAY 26, 4TH OF JULY, AND LABOR DAY SEPTEMBER 1).

TIPS FOR SUCCESSFUL REGISTRATION

1. Fill out the form **COMPLETELY**; incomplete or missing information will delay your registration.
2. Add all program fees and information and send a check or credit card information for the total. **DO NOT SEND CASH.** Make checks payable to the City of Casa Grande. **Returned checks are subject to a \$25 processing fee.**
3. Dropped off registrations **DO NOT** receive priority over mail-in registrations. All registration received prior to the registration date (May 5, 2014) will be mixed together and randomly selected for processing.
4. We make every attempt to satisfy your request, but cannot guarantee placement. All classes and activities are subject to change depending upon instructor availability and minimum/maximum enrollment and are subject to cancellation due to insufficient enrollment.
