



CASA GRANDE FIRE DEPARTMENT FIRE EXTINGUISHER TRAINING

The CG Fire Department teaches the fire extinguisher classes in following manner:

- 1) Instructional PowerPoint presentation (15 minutes)
- 2) Hands-on fire extinguisher training using ABC fire extinguishers.
(2 minute per student)

For the In-class Training-

We will need a classroom/training room big enough to hold all personnel receiving the training, a computer/laptop, projector and screen for PowerPoint training. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A COMPUTER, PROJECTOR, AND SCREEN PLEASE LET ME KNOW AS SOON AS POSSIBLE and we will bring our own.

For the Hands-on Training-

We use a Fire Extinguisher Training Trailer which needs to be parked on a paved or concrete, level area that is 25 ft. from any other structure or from any items which may catch on fire. WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO CONDUCT THE TRAINING IN WIND OVER 10 MPH. Our trailer is structured as a water-fire pit so we will need a source of water (an outside water hose) to fill it.

We suggest you have one (5 lbs.) fire extinguisher per 3 students. Should you not have any extinguishers available, the CGFD can provide them with an additional \$35 recharge fee per extinguisher.



SAFETY FIRST

Our classes are taught during business working hours (Mon-Fri. 8:00 a.m. to 5:00p.m.) however we can be flexible depending on the circumstances. We ask that you schedule your class at least two weeks in advance. Please contact martha_bender@casagrandeaz.gov or call 520-421-8777 ex. 5980 for scheduling.

Payment-

There is a \$50 fee per class with a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 20 students. You will be invoiced for the training which will be due 30 days from service. There are two ways you will be able to pay: you can mail or bring your payment to:
