Holiday Collection Schedule

Please place container(s) out for service no later than 6 a.m. on the day of scheduled service.

If the holiday is on Monday

Trash collection normally picked up on Monday is picked up on Tuesday, and Tuesday collection is picked up on Wednesday.

If the holiday is on Wednesday

Trash collection does not take place on Wednesday, so services are not affected due to a holiday.

Independence Day Holiday

Thursday Trash will be collected on Wednesday, and Friday trash will be collected on Thursday

Thanksgiving Holiday

Thursday Trash will be collected on Wednesday, and Friday trash will be collected as normal on Friday

Thursday Trash will be collected on Wednesday, and Friday trash will be collected as normal on Friday

Please place your container out by the curb before 6 a.m. on your scheduled pickup days (or the night before). Due to the large number of containers collected every day, drivers do not return to pickup containers that were placed out late. Collection vehicles are equipped with Geo-Tracking which allows staff to monitor the location and time a vehicle has serviced an area.

Please remember to remove your container from the curb the same day it is serviced.

Trash Collection Helpful Hints

Please Do

*Place your trash container in the street as close to the curb as possible, with the container handle and wheels facing your house.

*Keep the lid on your container closed to reduce the odor and not attract flies.

*Save space by cutting up brush and other large items, such as cardboard boxes before placing them in the container.

*Bag & Tie garbage, grass, animal waste, diapers and food waste.

Please Do Not

*Overfill container with brush or other materials. The lid must be closed in order for your container to be picked up.

*Place garbage on the ground around the container. All garbage must be in the container for pickup.

*Place hot ashes, cinders, coals, spent fireworks, or any other burning materials in the container.

*Fill up your container with concrete, dirt or anything too heavy for our trucks to pick up.

*Place container on the sidewalk.

*Take container with you when you move.

*Let children play inside or around the container or collection trucks.

Note - Replacement fee will be assessed if damage to container was due to negligence

Uncontained Trash Alley and Curbside Service

The City operates on a six-week collection schedule (divided into six collection zones) to pickup uncontained trash in the alleys and from residents requesting curbside pickup.

Residents with alley collection are requested to place uncontained trash behind their home for collection no earlier than the weekend before the scheduled collection week.

To help ensure the City will continue to provide alley trash service to areas currently being served, residents must maintain the alley free of litter and trash up to the centerline of the alley for their segment. The exception is for the placement of uncontained trash in the alley for scheduled zone collection no earlier than the weekend before the zones scheduled pickup.

Residents with curbside service are requested to place uncontained trash no earlier than the weekend before the scheduled collection day.

Residents with curbside service must call to schedule a pick up by 3 p.m. Friday prior to the scheduled collection day at (520)421-8625.

Sanitation crews begin collecting trash at 6 a.m. on the Monday of the scheduled collection week. Materials must be placed before 6 a.m. to assure collection.

Items Not Accepted at the Landfill

Tires: The landfill does not accept tires. Contact Pinal County Public Works Material Recovery Center at (520) 866-6685 for information on tire recycling.

Appliances: The City will pickup refrigerators or other appliances with Freon. There is a \$30 charge to recover the cost of Freon removal. Residents may also take appliances to the Landfill.

Used Motor Oil or Antifreeze: The City does not dispose of or recycle motor oil or antifreeze. Check with supplier to see if they will accept used oil.

Hazardous Waste: The City does not accept hazardous waste for disposal. For information on hazardous waste disposal, please contact the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality at 1(800) 234-5677 or Heritage Environmental Services at (520) 723-4167. Heritage will accept household hazardous waste from Casa Grande residents for a fee.

Diabetic Lancets/Sharps: The landfill does not accept Diabetic Lancets/Sharps. Contact Healthcare Medical Waste Services at (520) 316-9207 for information on disposal services.
