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PROJECT INFORMATION

Over recent years, the city of Casa Grande has seen many historic signs removed and/or destroyed from their urban landscape. In an effort to abate the disappearance of the historic signs of Casa Grande, the city of Casa Grande staff and Historic Preservation Commission members embarked on an effort to identify and protect the remaining historic signs. Initially, information was gathered on remaining signs that had held history and interest to Casa Grande, compiling a preliminary list, City of Casa Grande Local Historic Register, together with some historical information and photographs. The City applied for, and received a grant from the State Historic Preservation Office to fund a preservation consultant to supplement this work, and to evaluate and provide recommendations on potential eligibility to the city's local historic register. Motley Design Group was engaged in May, 2016 to provide these services.

The Casa Grande Historic Sign Survey creates an official record of the potentially historic signs and to provide basic guidelines for eligibility to the City of Casa Grande Local Historic Register. The inclusion of signs on the local register would provide a layer of protection for the historic signs (that are in some cases endangered) under the Casa Grande Historic Preservation Overlay. This will give the city of Casa Grande an opportunity to preserve these valuable contributors to the historic landscape.

METHODOLOGY

The location of the signs listed on the preliminary City of Casa Grande Local Historic Register (CGLHR) defined an approximate survey area (Figure 1). Any additional resources encountered by the consultant team within the approximate survey area were added to the CGLHR, but a comprehensive street-by-street survey was not within the scope of work.

The CGLHR identified seventy-five (75) sign resources: the list provided has eighty-four (84) entries but some resources were listed multiple times as they fit in several categories. Nearly half of the resources are associated with properties already listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Other sign resources were identified and listed by a general type classification. The following is a list of type categories identified on the preliminary CGLHR:


- HR – Signs associated with properties listed National Register of Historic Places
- NR – Not Previously Registered Property
- GS – Ghost Signs
- M – Signs currently stored at the Casa Grande Historical Museum
- E – Endangered Signs
- VW – Vintage Walls Signs

These preliminary CGLHR identifications can be found on the current survey forms. In most cases, this preliminary identification was used in the as the main description of the signs for this survey.

The consultant team spent one day in the field to locate, document and photograph each sign or property. Each associated property on the city's initial list was visited and photographed regardless of whether the sign was still extant or not.

All survey information and photographs were entered into a Microsoft Access database to produce survey inventory forms. The form that was used was patterned after the standard State Historic Preservation Office survey form for buildings, modified to reflect the subject and purpose of this specific survey.

Much of the historical research was provided to the consultant by the city as part of its in-kind match. The consultant team supplemented this information by conducting focused research on each sign to determine the connection with its current environment. In addition to the information provided by Marge Jantz of the Preservation Commission, this research accessed the following resources: The Museum of Casa Grande Photographic Collections (online), Digital Archives of the Casa Grande Public Library, National Register of Historic Places Listing in Pinal County, Arizona (online). Additional research was performed to further weave the results of this survey with the larger history of signs and sign architecture.



HISTORIC CONTEXT

Commercial Signage in Casa Grande, Arizona 1879-1970

Casa Grande's commercial signage is a product of its economic development. Understanding the city's growth is necessary to evaluate the current assemblage of historic signs. The community's history links the commercial signs to the business environment that produced these outdoor advertisements.

Since its inadvertent founding in 1879, Casa Grande has undergone an evolution from an economy based on railroad and mining to one in which agriculture, industry, and tourism are the major contributors. While these economic changes impacted commercial signage in Casa Grande, the most important event from a historic sign perspective occurred when highways were constructed linking the city to Arizona, and the nation, beginning in the 1920s.

Prior to the highways, Casa Grande businesses predominantly marketed their products and services to those living in or near the community. A short commercial strip, located along Main Street across from the passenger train station, also served arriving railroad passengers.

The commercial landscape evolved quickly when the city joined the nation's road network. Highway traffic created demand for roadside services, especially gas, food, and lodging. These individual businesses competed against each other for motorists in Casa Grande and in other communities along the highway routes. Increased business competition along the roadside created larger and more elaborate commercial signs to attract travelers. Many of Casa Grande's most important signs were created in this halcyon era of outdoor advertising, which lasted from the late 1920s until local ordinances and corporate influence reined in the size, location, and design of outdoor advertisements beginning in the 1960s.

Railroad Era / Hand Painted Signs

Casa Grande was unceremoniously founded when the Southern Pacific Railroad, building tracks eastward from California, temporarily halted construction because of heat and delayed deliveries of rail from the east in May 1879. The temporary camp established at the railhead was named Terminus, for its location at the "end of the line." The settlement, which consisted of five people and three buildings, persisted once work resumed and the railhead moved east in January 1880.

The city's origin is important in that its location was happenstance; settlers weren't attracted to the site for any particular feature such as a water source or compelling physical attribute. As such, visitors to Casa Grande were typically bound for other points, using the town as a convenient stop for services or goods.

Upon renewed construction of the Southern Pacific tracks eastward bound, the community was renamed Casa Grande in 1881 after the ancient Hohokam ruins located 20 miles to the northeast. These ruins, first declared the Casa Grande Reservation in 1892, were re-designated a national monument in 1918.

Linking the community, which at the time was the closest settlement to the ruins, to the world famous archeological site seemed a wise promotional move. The nearby town of Coolidge, founded in 1925, became however, the gateway to the national monument.

The few settlers that Casa Grande attracted during this era were there for the economic opportunity offered by the railroad and nearby mining operations. The population had grown enough by 1890 to warrant the creation of the Casa Grande townsite.

Historic photos from this era reveal a hardscrabble Western town with limited commercial enterprises except for a general store and saloons located along Main Street, which paralleled the railroad tracks to the northeast ([Figure 1](#)). These businesses advertised their wares through hand-painted signs on their storefronts, a form of advertising that would continue to be used in Casa Grande through the 1930s and beyond. These inexpensive signs fulfilled their mission in attracting residents, which numbered only 250 as late as 1910.

Hand-painted signs, often called ghost signs if their businesses are no longer extant, are still found from later periods in Casa Grande's development. These advertisements are typically painted on the facades or sides of brick buildings to promote the business or the goods or services it offered. These signs are surprisingly durable, largely because of the presence of lead in the paint which helps it firmly adhere to the brick or metal surface.

Commercial ghost signs include those on brick buildings at the 1922 Pioneer Market ([CGSS 14](#)) ([Figure 2](#)) and the 1948 Cobbs Department Store ([CGSS 17](#)), which proclaims, "Complete Home Furnishings." Another ghost sign is painted on the corrugated metal side of the J.J. Kruse Building ([CGSS 59](#)), which reads "Tito Montez presents Wrestling Every Sat," a popular local event in the 1960s.

Painted signs continue to advertise several businesses including the 1930 Tri-Valley Pump building ([CGSS 73](#)), several layered signs at the Valley Pump and Machine Works building

constructed in 1934, and a “Casa Grande” rooftop sign at the 1942-era Casa Grande Bulk Plant (CGSS 75).

While all are interesting from a local perspective, the rooftop sign at the Casa Grande Bulk Plant is the most significant. The sign was part of a low-technology navigation system that allowed aircraft pilots to navigate by rooftop signs. By 1941, more than 13,000 had been painted on all sorts of buildings. The Civil Aeronautics Administration launched a program in 1926 to promote air marking, painting the name of a local airport on a nearby building’s roof with an arrow pointing in the airport’s direction, or simply the name of the town with an arrow indicating north.¹ Navigation charts and radio made these signs mostly obsolete by the 1950s, though the Casa Grande sign might have been created to aid local crop dusters.

Agricultural Era / Illuminated Signs

As railroad shipments or ore from mines near Casa Grande declined in the 1890s, agricultural opportunities reinvigorated the community, which became incorporated in 1915. Town boosters marketed Casa Grande to “the farmer, the business man, and the home seeker” in the 1920s (Figure 3).² The completion of Coolidge Dam in 1930, which impounded the Gila River, provided additional water for farm irrigation. The town attracted agricultural-related industry, including the short-lived Kadota Fig Cannery.³ Still, Casa Grande remained a small community of modest wealth with a population of 1,351 in 1930.

Casa Grande’s business district, adjacent to the railroad, continued along Main Street and consisted of a strip of hotels, cafes, bars, banks, drugstores, a lumberyard, and other businesses (Figure 4). Signs continued to be created that were oriented towards local commerce. This

commercial district would be dominant until the 1960s when new mercantile construction occurred along the highways leading into the city.

Electricity came to Casa Grande in 1916, offering business owners the opportunity for sign illumination. The surviving commercial signs from this era are mostly utilitarian and informative, except for the reconstructed neon marquee at the Paramount Theater (CGSS 19), built in 1928.

Although newly illuminated, most downtown Casa Grande signs surviving from this era use traditional simple geometric rectangular shapes. The content was kept to a minimum, with the business name usually taking precedence over the function.

Each sign, however, had its unique personality created with fonts, color schemes, and design. There were some commonalities as the signs' letters were painted in light colors against a darker background color to emphasize their message. This made the signs useful during the day, particularly with the added depth provided by shadows cast by the projecting neon tubes. The use of light-colored letters also ensured that neon light would reflect off the sign's surface.

Downtown signs following this pattern include the Don Market (CGSS 39) built in 1940, and O'Malleys Lumber (CGSS 79) a projecting blade sign installed in 1945. Other signs in the business district followed vertically oriented symmetrical patterns including Goddard Shoes (CGSS 63) created in 1945 and Reliable Furniture (CGSS 51) installed in 1948.

While these are all interesting from a local perspective, the most noteworthy surviving sign is from the Gorraiz Photo Shop (CGSS 71), which was created in 1950. Although currently in storage, the galvanized steel sheet box sign is in the shape of a 1920s folding camera. Although no longer possessing any neon tubing, "Photo Shop" is painted on the surface. Most similar signs for camera shops or photography studios across the country have been removed, and few remain on public display.

Highways / Elaborate Signs

Casa Grande was fortunate to have many resources that contributed to its success as a community. Founded by chance by the railroad, the site had limited nearby mineral resources. When the ore bodies became depleted, a long growing season, fertile soils and water for irrigation supported farming. And Casa Grande had yet another unforeseen advantage: the town was situated along a short-cut of a major coast-to-coast highway.

U.S. Highway 80, called the Broadway of America, linked Savannah, Georgia to San Diego, California beginning in 1926. Although less famous than Route 66, it arguably was more important. This all-weather southern route carried many more vehicles to California than did the "Mother Road."

The highway had a serendipitous route through Arizona. From Tucson, U.S. Highway 80 went north through Florence to Apache Junction, and veered westward through Mesa, Phoenix, and Buckeye before dropping south to Gila Bend and continuing its westward path to Yuma.

There existed, however, a more direct route for motorists. Arizona Highway 84, also known as the Tucson-Casa Grande Highway, went in a more northwesterly direction, entering Casa Grande and then turning west to Gila Bend. The Tucson-Picacho portion of the highway was completed in 1927, and the added segment through Casa Grande to Gila Bend was finished in 1928 and known as the Gila Bend Highway.




Figure 5. 1935 Arizona Roadmap Showing Arizona Highway 84, Arizona Department of Transportation

A shortcut for traffic between San Diego and Tucson, this route saved motorists many miles and hours as an alternative to U.S. Highway 80 (Figure 5). A "Shortcuts Association" was formed in 1952 to promote a quicker route that bypassed Phoenix. This would be the main highway to bring auto traffic into Casa Grande, until the creation of Interstate 8 and 10 in the 1960s and 1970s.

Other local highways of lesser importance to the development of Casa Grande were constructed in the 1930s. Arizona Route 287, now known as Florence Boulevard, entered Casa Grande from due east (Figure 6). Heading north from downtown was Arizona Route 187, a stretch of highway later known as Arizona Route 387 or Pinal Avenue.

These routes, especially Arizona Highway 84, had a significant impact on Casa Grande's commercial signage. Previously, utilitarian signs were used to guide local residents or visitors arriving by train, to goods and services. Highway traffic brought in transient motorists largely unfamiliar with Casa Grande, who based their purchase of goods and services, in large part, on commercial signs.

These potential customers were not only comparing Casa Grande businesses to each other, but to other options in communities along the roadside. Were California-bound motorists inspired to stop overnight in the "Old Pueblo" of Tucson, continue to Casa Grande, or push on to Gila Bend?

The new highways created roadside gas stations, cafes, and cabin cottages oriented towards highway travelers by the early 1930s ([Figure 7](#)). As autos and roads improved, nighttime driving increased, which meant businesses needed illuminated signs to compete along the roadside. Although electrified signs existed in parts of the country since the 1890s, the availability of neon lighting during the 1930s transformed signs across America.

Some early highway-oriented neon signs that remain in Casa Grande followed a traditional rectangular shape with simple and direct messages common in business districts. Examples of these include the Airport Tavern (CGSS 36), erected in 1945 but removed in March 2013, and the Sunset Court sign (CGSS 62), which is currently being stored by the city. The latter sign is set off by a symbolic blue and yellow sunrise, similar to the design of the Arizona State flag.




Figure 8. Photo Douglas Towne, 2005

To increase their effectiveness, signs evolved, through marketplace competition, into more abstract shapes to be more dynamic and innovative. This trend is revealed in several unique designs such as the kidney-shaped Wonder Bar (CGSS 46) created in 1942⁴ ([Figure 8](#)) and the Casa Grande Dispatch sign (CGSS 38), a curvilinear amoeba sign created in 1954. Another unusual form is the hexagon-shaped S.S. Blinky Jr. building sign (CGSS 22). Installed in 1946, this "ship in the desert" was constructed as a gas station and automobile salesroom to honor the owner's son who was serving in the Navy during World War II ([Figure 9](#)).

Three Casa Grande motel signs illustrate other sign trends that occurred starting in the 1940s. These included using bold regional Western names or themes on signs that were no longer attached to the motel, but were installed on stanchions next to the highway. These motels include the Boots & Saddle Motel sign (CGSS 37) created in 1944, which features a

"Thunderbird" motif and an expressive arrow pointing towards the motel ([Figure 10](#)), the Se-Tay Motel (CGSS 45) installed in 1948, which gives the impression of being a Native American term but is actually the original owner's name, "Yates," spelled backward ([Figure 11](#)), and the Horseshoe Motel (CGSS 61) put up in 1960 and currently stored by the city ([Figure 12](#)).

The trend toward abstraction in sign design continued into the 1950s, with some later advertisements becoming one-of-a-kind novelty displays featuring irregular shapes and a wide variety of materials to attract customers. These signs were built taller for easier viewing by motorists from greater distances and higher speeds. The Sofia's Restaurant (CGSS 31) sign, created in 1960, fits this novelty category. The sign's stanchion features an elongated rectangular box, above which are three oval boxes topped by a neon "fountain." While the design is still intact, all the sign's details are missing. The neon "fountain" remains but the remainder of the sign's glass tubing is missing, and all the boxes have been painted over.

By the early 1960s, heavy steel signs with elaborate neon displays were falling out of favor for new installations, being replaced by lightweight and inexpensive plastic signs that were easy to transport and install. Their backgrounds, often white, mimicked white paper and offered three-dimensional letters which were more attractive than flat signs. The entire face of the sign could be illuminated and didn't need repainting. Several memorable Casa Grande signs fit this category, including the Little Sombrero along Florence Boulevard, which reflects its 1969 origin. The sombrero imagery and namesake identify the fare, and the food was marketed as "Mexican & American Food" so as not to appear too exotic for customers' tastes. Another unusual plastic sign is Milo's Discount Liquor Drive Thru (CGSS 78), which features an internally lit box design on a pole. The business name is provided on all four sides.

The Dairy Queen sign (CGSS 64) is another backlit plastic sign, which is believed to have been installed in the early 1960s ([Figure 13](#)). The only other Dairy Queen sign with this "lips" design and protruding ice cream cone is in Topeka, Kansas.⁵ The Casa Grande City Council designated the sign as a local landmark in April 2016. However, the Dairy Queen Corporation is still encouraging the Casa Grande outlet

Casa Grande's Historic Signs Today

A community's commercial sign resources are influenced by its prosperity, population size, major pre-Interstate highways, and tourist appeal. Casa Grande, throughout the period encompassed by the sign survey, was a relatively small and modest community. The city's population was only 1,545 in 1940, increasing to 10,536 by 1970. The city functioned as a service center for nearby agricultural operations such as cotton and dairy farms, but was eclipsed by nearby Phoenix and Tucson for many products and services.

Because of these factors, Casa Grande does not possess the numbers and variety of signs found in larger Arizona cities such as Phoenix, Tucson, Mesa, and Flagstaff. Still, Casa Grande possesses some remarkable signs, interesting on a local scale and significant regionally and even nationally. The city's historic signs have benefited from the lack of development pressure in older areas of the community and less local competition from national chains.

SURVEY RESULTS

The purpose of this survey is to establish local designation eligibility criteria and apply that criteria to the extant commercial signs of Casa Grande. The signs on the CGLHR list tended to be historic signs, where many were associated with previously recognized historic properties in Casa Grande. Others had historic elements where for example the structure of the signs was perhaps original, but the sign itself matched a current, non-historic occupant of the associated business. A few others are reproductions of much older signs.

Eligibility Criteria

The subjects of the sign survey are being evaluated primarily for their eligibility to Casa Grande's local Historic Property Register. Under National Register criteria, signs, in and of themselves, are seldom eligible on their own – only as elements of larger historic resources such as buildings or districts. Local designation can be more flexible and take into account the visual contribution of an individual sign to the community. It is important, however, to develop a consistent rationale for determining whether or not a given sign belongs on a local register, which is grounded in recognized preservation philosophy.

The criteria for eligibility used for the survey are patterned after the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) guidelines, with a few modifications for signs specifically. Other large scale sign inventories were also researched and their guidelines were considered. For this survey, the individual signs were evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Over **40 years old**
- *Displays a unique or novelty design*
- *Displays good integrity where most of the intrinsic elements of the design of the sign are present*
- **Contributes to context** where sign enhances the environment or associated property/business; in most cases, the sign will still be in its original location.

To be eligible to the National Register, an age of 50 years is usually required. For this survey and other sign surveys, as well as many local criteria, a 40 year threshold is used. This includes signs that would be associated with properties not eligible as Historic Register (local or national) but would still be worthy of protection. For purposes of historic resource management, a 40-year criterion also provides a 10-year “look-ahead” to potential National Register eligibility.

Additionally, eligible signs show some distinction in design including novelty neon signs or shaped metal/plaster signs that can often be considered individually or are affiliated with an existing or historic business. Where the associated building is recognized on the National, state, or local registers, the associated sign can be considered to be a contributing element to the historic property.

Eligible signs must possess good historical integrity; that is, they must still exhibit most of the elements of a certain sign type. For example, neon signs will have existing neon tubes, and hardware as well as having the appropriate attachment hardware or pole. It is possible that

some signs parts would be in varying degrees of distress, particularly older signs. This is not typically a consideration for integrity, but rather condition.

A sign that retains its original context reinforces its association in the business landscape. In most cases, the signs are in the original locations and are associated with historic uses of the associated properties. In a few cases, the signs were removed from the original location, for protection or salvage purposes, and are being temporarily stored. Eligibility in those cases is incumbent on whether the signs can be returned to the original location; or if the sign can be utilized for a business of associated historic use. In one unique case, a gas station reader sign was relocated to a historic residence, formerly used as a realtor's office. While the sign does appear to meet the age criterion, it is out of context, having been relocated from another city, and out of context with the historic and current use of the property.


As a result of the research/survey, the signs were determined to be eligible, ineligible or conditionally eligible as follows:

- **Sign Eligible** can be identified as such for its individual merits and/or its contribution to an existing historic-listed property. This would indicate that a sign is in its original location or salvaged with good material integrity or has the potential to be repaired/restored. The sign shows significance in its design and construction individually, or it is associated with National Register of Historic Places or locally listed property and contributes to its historic character.
- **Sign Not Eligible** is classified as such for one of several reasons. No Sign Extant refers to a sign is no longer at the location and has not been salvaged or stored. In this survey, signs were either removed or covered over by new paint or stucco finishes. Sign Not Significant/ Loss of Integrity, Age and/or Context identified signs not significant for one of three possible reasons. It is not significant through Loss of Integrity if the sign is in a deteriorated or altered condition that is not repairable. A sign is not significant for age if it is less than 40 years old. The sign is not significant by context if it is no longer in the original location and there is no information to connect to a specific location for replacement. These signs are typically considered not eligible.
- **Sign Conditionally Eligible** category classifies those signs that have been removed from the original location but were salvaged by the city of Casa Grande and stored at one of two locations: The Casa Grande Historic Society Museum or the city of Casa Grande South Storage Facility. These signs could either be designated conditionally eligible or ineligible depending on the condition or context.


Age Determination

For most signs the age is approximated. While our research clarified construction dates for buildings and occupation dates for businesses, it was not possible to exactly determine dates of the signs except from precise records, likely held by the individual businesses. Since many buildings have had several uses/occupants over the decades, it was possible to narrow a sign to

Map 1. Location of Survey Properties




Map 2. Location of Survey Properties

the building and its use in most cases. For other signs, the style and type of the sign matched that of the associated building so it is likely that the signs dated to the building construction.

Eligibility Recommendations

A total of eighty-one (81) properties were surveyed and documented, including five (5) added by the consultants during the field survey. However, a total of 84 signs are included in this survey, with CGSS 76, The BPOE Lodge, having four contributing signs.

Eligible signs: Signs are identified as eligible are those that meet all or most of the criteria stipulated above. These are either eligible individually, or as signs that contribute to an existing or potentially eligible National Register of Historic Places buildings. In some cases, both are true. Of the eighty-one (81) total surveyed, thirty-two (32) are eligible for the Casa Grande Historic Sign Register. In all but one case, the signs are original in design, material and location. For that specific case, the Paramount Theatre marquee is eligible because it is a careful reproduction of signs the Paramount has used over the decades, and enhances the façade of the property and contributes to the identity of the property.

Conditionally eligible signs: Five (5) of the salvaged signs would be considered eligible if restored and placed back to their original locations. In the case of the Horse Shoe Motel, the original associated historic property has been demolished, but a return to the original location would provide visual statement of the historic streetscape.

Ineligible signs: Lastly, forty-four (44) were identified as ineligible. This includes twelve (12) that are no longer extant. Several of the stored salvaged signs are considered ineligible, primarily because no direct connection could be found to an historic building or business. Twenty-eight (28) signs are classified as not significant either because of integrity loss, change in context, or being less than 40 years old. These signs tended to be basic in design and, in most cases, the signs and/or associated businesses were researched and found to be less than 40 years old.

Listing or Recognition of Eligible Signs

Eligible signs associated with a building already listed on the national, State, or local registers should be recognized as a contributing element of the property. Where possible, forms for those properties should be amended to reflect the contribution of the sign to the overall property, and design review of these properties should take preservation of the historic signs into account.

The remaining eligible signs that are standing alone should be considered for listing in the city of Casa Grande Historic Register and for protection under the Historic Preservation ordinance. In many cases, the stand-alone eligible signs are associated with potentially eligible historic buildings/properties, not currently listed or recognized. It is recommended that these properties should be noted for further study.
